Press release: Slovenian support to Serbia in strengthening capacities for management of patrols in full swing

With the successful implementation of the meeting and introductory workshop on 5 September 2019 the fieldwork in Serbia started as part of the development assistance of the Republic of Slovenia, which is aimed at strengthening patrol management and responding effectively to the needs of the people when police intervention is needed. These are reforms in the area of freedom and security, which is also important for Serbia in terms of EU accession (Chapter 24). The aim is to upgrade the response and coordination of patrols and organizational units, and to strengthen the effective police response to any existing situation, especially with regard to migration, thereby increasing protection of human lives and human rights. This project contributes to building both human and technical capabilities.

Both sides, Serbian and Slovenian, confirmed the importance of the project by their active attendance, with participation of high-level representatives from all areas of police competence gathered at the meeting. They laid the groundwork for future work in the year 2019, which will continue 16 - 20 September 2019 by conducting a field visits to analyse the situation on the field and needs in various organizational units. After field visit, the work will proceed with the study visit of Serbian representatives in Slovenia, through which they will be able to learn on the ground how patrols are managed in Slovenia and how information and telecommunications equipment is used in Slovenia.



The project is part of program activities carried out in cooperation with the Ministry of the Interior / Police of the Republic of Slovenia and CVS Mobile, and is financed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Slovenia from funds for international development cooperation.

SPOROČILO ZA JAVNOST: Slovenska podpora Srbiji pri krepitvi zmogljivosti upravljanja patrolj v polnem zamahu

S sestankom in uvodno delavnico 5.9.2019 so se pričele terenske aktivnosti v Srbiji v okviru razvojne pomoči Republike Slovenije, ki je usmerjene v krepitev upravljanja patrolj in učinkovito odzivanje na potrebe ljudi, ko je potrebno posredovanje policije, Gre za reforme področja svobode in varnosti, ki je za Srbijo pomembna tudi z vidika vstopanja v EU (poglavje 24). Cilj je nadgraditi odziv in koordinacijo patrolj in organizacijskih enot in okrepiti učinkovito odzivanje policije na vsakokratne aktualne razmere, posebej še v zvezi z migracijami ter tako povečati varnost in zaščito človekovih pravic. Ob tem projekt prispeva k graditvi tako človeških kot tehničnih zmogljivosti.

Pomembnost projekta sta obe strani potrdili z udeležbo saj so se na srečanju zbrali visokih predstavniki iz vseh pristojnosti dela policije. Postavili so dobre temelje za prihodnje delo v tem letu, ki se bo nadaljevalo 16.-20.9.2019 z izvedbo terenske analize stanja in potreb v različnih organizacijskih enotah in študijskih obiskom srbskih predstavnikov v Sloveniji, skozi katerega bodo lahko na terenu in skozi primere spoznali, kako poteka upravljanje patrolj v Sloveniji in kako se pri tem uporablja informacijsko-telekomunikacijska oprema.
